A striking portrait of a girl in traditional North African dress, depicted with finely modeled features, symbolic tattoos, and layered jewelry. The composition, conceived to be displayed on the diagonal, emphasizes the sitter's tranquil, inward gaze and the geometries of her headdress. The vivid palette—ochres, reds, and greens—contrasts with the subtle modeling of flesh tones and the careful detailing of embroidered fabric and beadwork. Signed, titled, and dated in the right: "Ch. Cluytmans, Oranan, 1916."

The painting is signed and dated by Charles Cluytmans, a little-documented artist active in colonial Algeria during the early 20th century. The inscription "Oranan" refers to the city of Oran, then part of French Algeria, known for its rich cultural interplay and ethnographic interest during the Orientalist period.
