The drawing is signed George Belcher at the lower right.

George Belcher (British, 1875-1947) was an illustrator, cartoonist, and painter active in the first half of the 20th century. He trained at Sheffield School of Art and later contributed cartoons and illustrations to Punch, The Tatler, and other periodicals. Belcher exhibited regularly at the Royal Academy, becoming an Associate in 1931 and a Royal Academician in 1936. His work included portraiture, genre scenes, and graphic illustration for British publications.
