ABOUT

This bronze alloy sculpture showcases a warrior standing near a pedestal, holding a staff adorned with a flag. The warrior wears a helmet with a laurel wreath, a chainmail arm vest, and a cape. The pedestal features an oval foliate frame with a compartment for a photograph. The attached photograph depicts an unknown man in military uniform. The sculptural composition rests on a square red marble base.

Signed on the left side of the bronze base: "H. Fugere". The bronze plate on the marble base states: "La Recompense par Fugere (Sculpt.)". The inscription on the ribbon states: "Honneur et Patrie" - refers to the flag of Honor and Fatherland.

Henri Fugere (1872-1944) was a renowned French sculptor and medallist engraver associated with the Art Deco style. His works showcased both playful bronzes of idealized beauties and realistic portrayals of soldiers and workers. Fugere's talent earned him recognition, and his legacy continues to be celebrated in the art world.
