ABOUT

Art Nouveau round purple vase with a crimped rim by the well-known glassmaker Legras. The burgundy color at the top gradually transitions into a more translucent green at the bottom. Enameled orchid flowers display vibrant colors and a polished finish. Adorned with a gilt rim and intricate details.

Legras & Cie is considered one of the best French glassmakers. Established by François-Théodore Legras in 1864, the firm specialized in acid-etched and enameled cameo glass, drawing inspiration from Émile Gallé, France's leading maker of decorative glass in the fashionable Art Nouveau style. During the first decade of the 1900s, Legras & Cie became a major exponent of the École de Nancy.

The firm produced a wide variety of commercial art glass, including both cameo and enamel-painted pieces. However, they also crafted large, high-quality pieces for international exhibitions, with only a few of these more elaborate examples surviving.
