"Tangiers" is a mixed media (gouache, pastel, pen and black ink on paper) painting, created by Bruno Beran during his travels in Morocco. The pastel-toned composition depicts several figures, with a focal point on a lady in yellow dress and white veil, walking with children. This artwork is characterized by its emotive depth, technical skill, and cultural relevance, combining traditional Orientalist topic and Modernist approach.

Signed "B.Beran" on the lower left. Circa 1955, when Bruno Beran received a commission by the US Information Office to depict daily life in Morocco and North Africa.

Bruno Beran (1888-1979) was a Czech artist known for his diverse and prolific body of work spanning painting, sculpture, and music. Born in Brno, Moravia, Beran showed exceptional artistic and musical talent from a young age. He received formal training at prestigious academies in Vienna, Munich, and Paris, where he was exposed to various artistic movements, including Secession, Expressionism, and Impressionism. Beran's art reflects a blend of classical tradition and modern influences, with a particular focus on portraiture that showcases his keen eye for detail and unique artistic vision. Throughout his life, Beran faced personal tragedies and political upheavals, leading him on a journey across continents before settling in Spain, where he continued to produce significant artworks.
